

VISITOR REGULATIONS

A church is a place of worship, a valuable legacy of our ancestors and a unique cultural monument.

All visitors of the church are warmly welcome. We kindly request to respect the sacred character of the church.

Inside the church visitors are required to follow the instructions of responsible people (a priest, a sacristan or any person in charge) and to obey the church regulations.

People not allowed to enter the church:

- people who are under the influence of alcohol or other drugs
- people wearing inappropriate, dirty or smelly clothes
- people not respecting basic hygienic and social standards and thus being a health risk for other visitors of the church
- people with animals, except for assistance and guide dogs

Inside the church it is not allowed to:

- smoke, eat and drink any kinds of food and drinks
- distract other visitors by begging, being loud, aggressive and behaving in inappropriate manner
- visit the church during church service and enter the assigned areas
- sell any kinds of goods, distribute commercial and advertising items or printed matters and promote any products
- damage the furniture in the church or the church itself
- disturb the holy silence in the church by talking loudly, singing, playing the musical instrument etc. (it is necessary to switch off your mobile phones or set the volume to minimum)
- take photographs of worshipers and take photographs of the church using a tripod
- make video or audio without the permission of the priest

Visitors who do not respect these regulations will be asked to leave the church. In case of a serious violation or not respecting the instructions of responsible people, the case will be passed to the competence of the police.
